

EURO ELECTION RESULTS - June 2004 for the three Highland Constituencies

The count in the three Highland constituencies for the sixth elections to the European Parliament took place at Inverness Sports Centre on Sunday 13 July. The average turnout was 32.9% - above the Scottish average, with 54,914 votes cast. The seven MEP's who will represent Scotland in the European Parliament will take up their duties on 20 July, when MEP's meet for the first time in Strasbourg to elect Parliament and Commission presidents. The existing eight members stand down on 19 July.
