The current 'preferred option' looks like an open house for development of renewable energy sources anywhere to accord with ad hoc decisions by the government. The preferred option doesn't say anything for the public to respond to. I accept that energy policy is largely a government driven issue, but disappointing that Highland Council can't find anything to say at all about the importance of defending its landscape heritage. In particular, I would like to see complete protection for the whole Caingorms National Park from all wind turbine developments, including areas close to the Park, such as the Dava Moor.

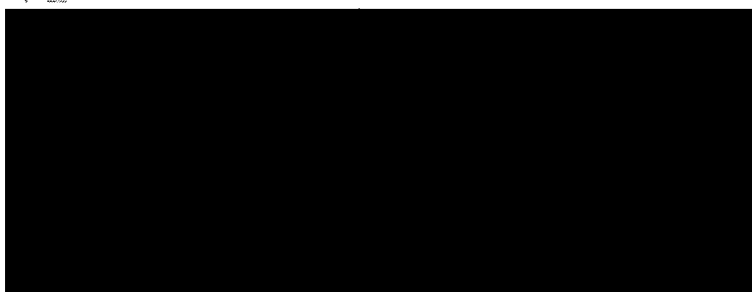
