The Skye and Lochalsh Archive Centre is housed in a wing of the former Elgin Hostel for Boys, designed by James Shearer (1881-1962) and opened by the Duke and Duchess of York in 1933. The building was commissioned to accommodate boys attending secondary school in Portree and is currently owned by the Highland Council. The Archive Centre occupies the original round recreation room and adjacent spaces. Please note that access on Doors Open Day will be to this area of the hostel only.
