AIMS

- To advance the education of the children of Inverness (Polish and all other ethnic and cultural backgrounds) through teaching Language, History, Music, Dance, Literature and Integration play.
- To encourage racial and social integration amongst children from the age of 5 upwards, so that they may take advantage of the rich varieties of culture at present in the Highlands.
- Through sharing in preparation for festivals and celebrations, to prevent the spread of racism and similar attitudes among young people in the Highlands, and to promote harmonious integration for the future.
- To increase the scope of leisure and recreation activities available to young people of ethnic minority backgrounds with the introduction and sharing of cultural information from Eastern Europe.
- To promote good race relations between people of different ethnic groups through the medium of shared activities to eliminate discrimination on grounds of race and thus to encourage equality of opportunity for all.
- To preserve and develop the cultural heritage of Poland and encourage knowledge of Scotland's culture and history.

The Inverness Polish Association plans the following :

1. The Club will start on 3rd May 2008—and run for the year, following normal school holiday patterns
2. The premises will be St Joseph's Primary School in King Street, Inverness
3. The club will be open from 1.00-5.00 pm on Saturday afternoons
4. Pupils over the age of 5 years are welcomed
5. A staff of 5 qualified Teachers will teach their appointed classes.
6. Adult English classes will be held
7. It is envisaged that short public performances featuring the children will be staged to mark various festivals.
