

CHANONRY POINT VISITOR MANAGEMENT PROPOSALS

INVITATION

(From Black Isle Highland Councillors Billy Barclay, David Alston, Craig Fraser, Isobel McCallum and Fortrose and Rosemarkie Community Council)

Over recent years, especially in the summer holidays, the growth in visitor numbers (140,000) and associated cars and buses at Chanonry Point has meant the existing car park and facilities are unable to cope.

The Highland Council commissioned a detailed report (funded by The Highland Council, LEADER and Fortrose and Rosemarkie Common Good Fund) to investigate the options and is proposing a range of measures to tackle congestion and improve the experience for local users and for people visiting Chanonry Point. Many people have interests in the Point but, at the end of the day, a pragmatic solution has to be found as the congestion and disturbance of past years has been to no one's benefit.
