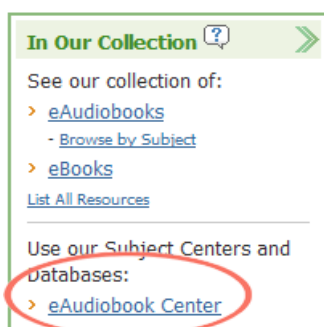


## Log-in to NetLibrary Account to start Downloading

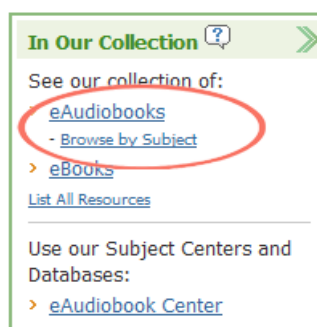

# Start Downloading eAudiobooks

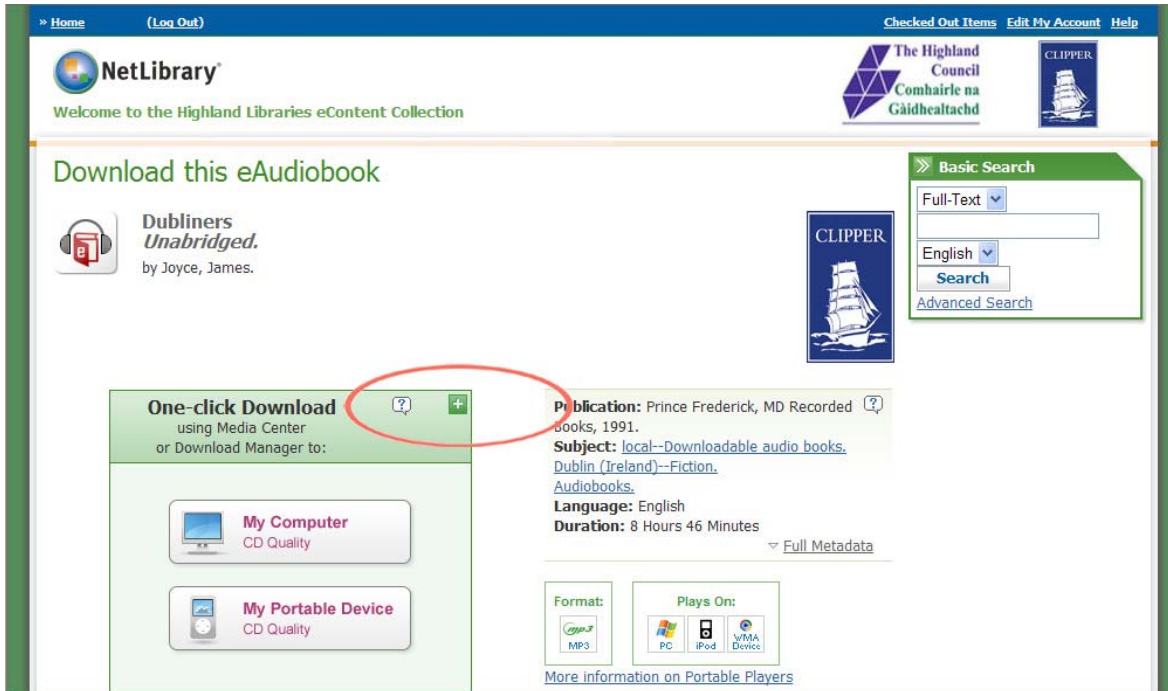
Once you have chosen an Audiobook you would like to borrow, it can be downloaded in one of two ways:

## 1. Manual Download (Recommended)

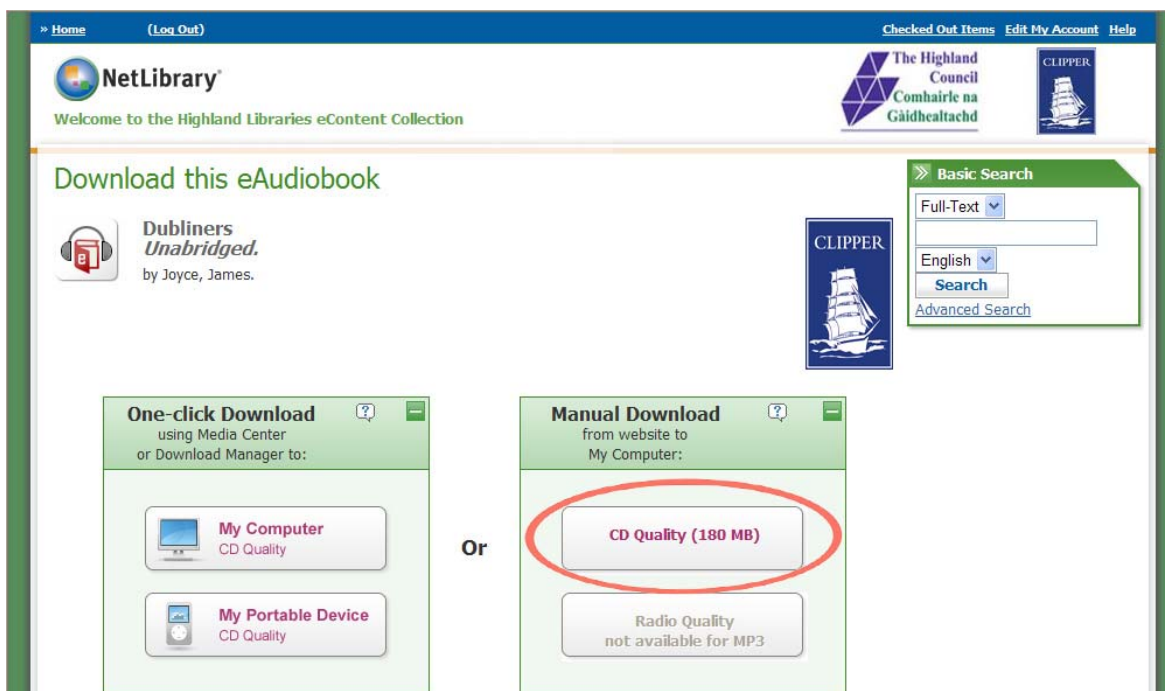
## 2. NetLibrary Media Centre

It is recommended you use the manual download method in conjunction with an existing download software such as Apple [iTunes](#)

Expand the options by clicking on the "+" symbol to show Manual and "One Click Download"




Click on the 'CD quality (305 MB)' under 'Manual Download' to check out the title



Please note: To download to **My Computer** or **My Portable Device** you must install NetLibrary media centre onto your computer and successfully check out the eAudiobook.

Click on '[download the eAudiobook](#)' displayed on the yellow box to begin the download.


