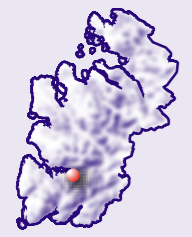

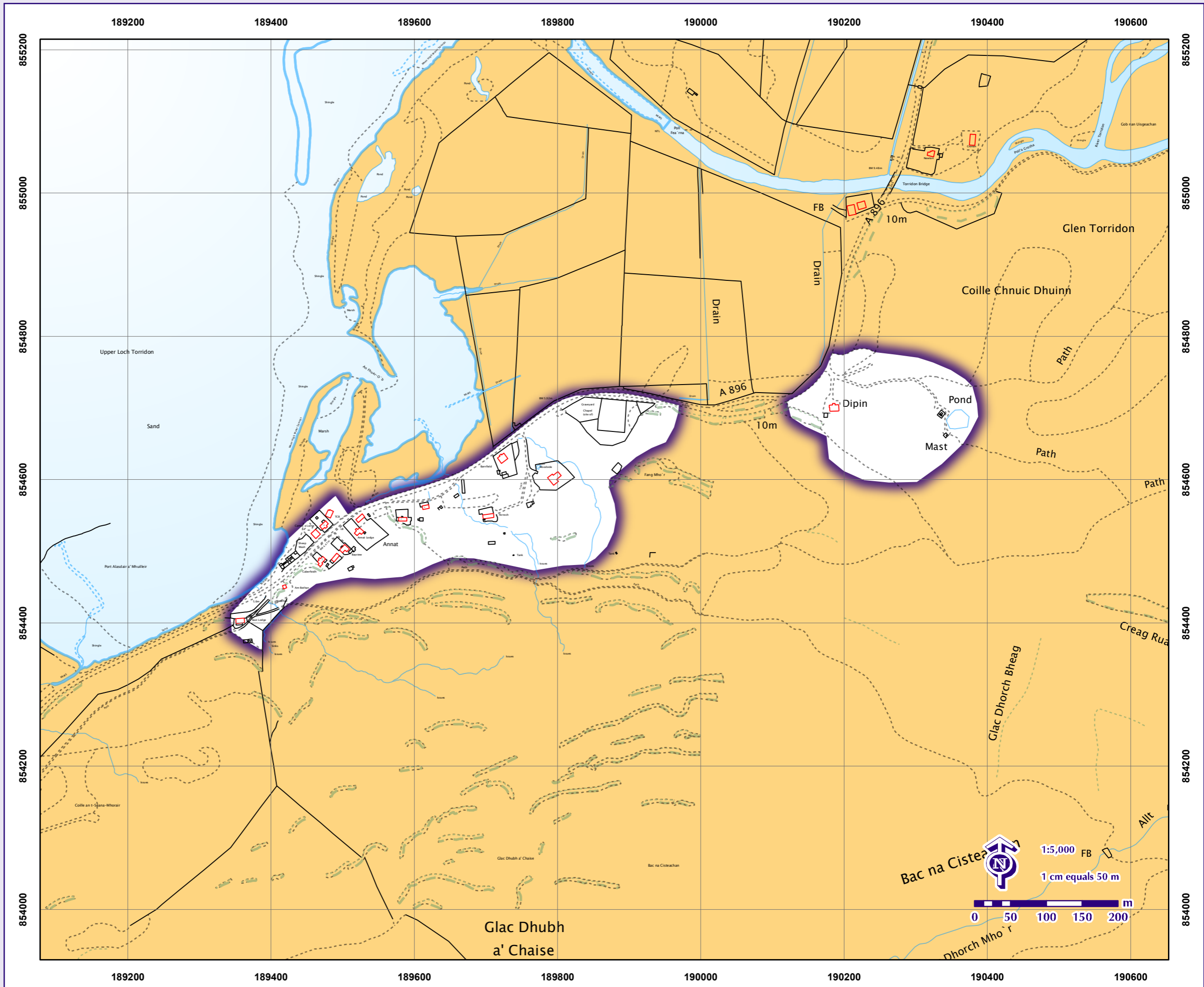
- Retain separation to Fasg (Torridon) to the north.
