LETTERS OF APPRECIATION

SUMMARY

To inform Members of letters received from 1 May to 31 July 2007.

The total number of letters of appreciation received from 1 May to 1 31 July 2007 is **62**.

A sample of "Letters of Appreciation" received, demonstrating the appreciation of recent work by officers:

- Miscellaneous: *"Without the help of the Police/Traffic Wardens, the Fair would probably grind to a halt at it's busiest times and would not be so successful, it would not be possible to hold it year after year without your co-operation."* (Letter 71)
- Road Traffic Incident: *"This young man was very helpful, reassuring, supportive and professional and his actions went way beyond the call of duty."* (Letter 72)
- Schools: *"...you can imagine all the school children when they heard this and then witnessed the policemen running off with their dogs. It's that kind of thing they will remember for years to come."* (Letter 62)
- Event: *"They have told me that all of your officers and staff were extremely helpful, allowing them free access to meetings, briefings, operational plans, etc., and that nothing was too much trouble despite all concerned being extremely busy."* (Letter 57)
