

## APPENDIX 10 (a)

### DEFINITION OF OPTIONS CONSIDERED

#### OPTION 1:

To build a new school on the existing Wick High School site with limited community facilities. Under this option, the original façade would be retained but the remainder of the existing school would be demolished and replaced. The existing community swimming pool, the Carnegie Library and the Assembly Rooms would remain open with some refurbishment undertaken.

#### OPTION 2:

To build a completely new school on the current High School playing fields with limited community facilities. Under this option the existing community swimming pool, the Carnegie Library and the Assembly Rooms would remain open with some refurbishment undertaken.

#### OPTION 3:

To build a completely new school on the Bignold Park site with enhanced community facilities. This option would include extended community facilities including a 25 meter (6 lane) swimming pool, a community library and a “performance venue” standard multi purpose hall with 220 seats. Under this option the existing community swimming pool, the Carnegie Library and the Assembly Rooms would close and be disposed off in accordance with Council policy

#### OPTION 4:

To build a completely new school on the current High School playing fields with enhanced community facilities. This option would include extended community facilities including a 25 meter (6 lane) swimming pool, a community library and a “performance venue” standard multi purpose hall with 220 seats. Under this option the existing community swimming pool, the Carnegie Library and the Assembly Rooms would close and be disposed off in accordance with Council policy

#### NOTE:

As a result of subsequent discussions it was agreed that the Assembly Rooms would remain open and continue as normal.
