This Report updates Members on recent Procurement activities and is submitted in accordance with the reporting arrangements set out in the Board's Standing Orders Relating to Contracts.

Contracts awarded through competition

1. The following Contracts have been awarded through competition:
2. Specialist Surveying Services A Framework agreement has been awarded to Graham and Sibbald for a period of 36 months. The value of this contract is between £80k and £120k.

3. Emergency Vehicle Equipment A Framework Agreement has been awarded to Premier Hazard Ltd for a period of 48 months. The value of this contract is between £80k and £100k.

 - c) The award criteria: Method of service delivery and price

5. A variation has been issued for NCC0115 Framework for the Provision of Vehicle Conversions to allow the contractor AJ Engineering Services Ltd to sub contract an element of the service provided.

7. Radio Mast Painting – Pre Qualification Questionnaires have been returned and evaluated. Invitations to tender will be issued shortly.
