NOTICE OF ORDER TO EXEMPT LAND FROM ACCESS RIGHTS  
THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (HIGHLAND CAR CLUB LTD SNOWMAN  
RALLY) ORDER 2012

Notice is hereby given under section 11(9) of the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003 (“the Act”) that on 26th January 2012 The Highland Council made The Highland Council (Highland Car Club Ltd Snowman Rally) Order 2012 (“the Order”) under section 11(1) of the Act.

The effect of the Order is to exempt parts of Meall Mor Forest, Ord Hill (North Kessock), Torr Achilty Forest, Boblainy Forest, Glen Urquhart (Delshangie, Lochletter and Shewglie Woods), except public rights of way and core paths, from the access rights which would otherwise be exercisable in respect of the land by virtue of Part 1 of the Act. Maps of the exempted areas can be viewed at The Highland Council Service Points in Dingwall and Inverness.

The purpose for which the Order is made is in the interests of safety to allow the staging of the Highland Car Club Ltd Snowman Rally 2012.

The Order will take effect:

On Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> February 2012

From 0730 to 1230 at Meall Mor Forest;

From 0800 to 1330 at Ord Hill, North Kessock;

From 0945 to 1500 at Torr Achilty Forest;

From 1130 to 1700 at Boblainy Forest; and

From 1215 to 1800 at Glen Urquhart (Delshangie, Lochletter and Shewglie Woods);

unless revoked earlier.
