Sec. 2.2

'The provision of a new resource base for pupils with additional support needs will be **considered** as part of the designs of the new builds.'

Sec. 6.2

'the use of the existing accommodation in Banavie School will be determined by the Head Teacher. **It may be possible** to retain the area as a learning support base/breakout space for future pupils with additional support needs....'
