## Special T&C's

1. Primary 1 to 5 Free School Meals are a Scottish government funded initiative.
2. The meal is optional.
3. Primary 1 to 5 children are only entitled to school meal at lunchtime – parents and carers need to provide pupils with money for any other service provision in school such as morning break or breakfast.
4. There is no application process involved.
5. Parents and carers of Primary 1 to 5 children still need to apply for clothing grants where applicable.
6. Parents and carers of children in Primary 6 & 7 if entitled still need to apply for Free School Meals following the usual process.
7. The Catering Service carefully consider all special diet applications, based on medical, cultural or religious belief. 8. Primary 1 to 5 children in schools with no meal provision will be entitled to reimbursement based on the economic daily rate for every day that the child has been in attendance at school.
