- 2. All figures include any windfall sites (4 or more houses) within the relevant Ward area
- 3. Programming figures are professional judgement applied and indicates capacity potential of sites. This does not suggest market demand or housing need but is a reflection of existing constraints on development and the suitability of sites for development for the periods specified
- 4. A small number of specific sites within the Inner Moray Firth area may not have programming figures as no builds are expected in these site
