REGULATED OFF STREET CAR PARKS CONTROL OF USE EXPLAINED

Car Parks operated by the Highland Council will be subject to “control of use” and will have a Traffic Regulation Order in place to support some or all of the following restrictions. Non-compliance with these restrictions would be dealt with as a contravention of the restrictions and lead to a Penalty Charge Notice of £60 being issued to offending vehicles and or the removal of the vehicle.

- (a) A restriction specifying the classes of vehicle which may use the parking area.
- (b) A restriction specifying the maximum time a vehicle may be left in the parking area.
- (c) A prohibition of overnight parking of caravans.
- (d) A prohibition of the storage of goods or the deposit of materials in the parking area.
- (e) Regulations relating to the manner in which vehicles must be parked.
- (f) A prohibition of unlicensed or un-roadworthy vehicles.
- (g) A prohibition of vehicle repairs except such repairs as are necessary to enable the vehicle to be removed from the parking area to a proper repair facility.
- (h) Regulations relating to manner of driving, prohibiting the running of engines of stationary vehicles etc.
- (i) The power to remove vehicles, goods or materials and store at the owners expense, and retain until such expenses have been reimbursed.
- (j) A prohibition of mobile trading and commercial promotions except for (by special and specific consent) the motoring organisations, the military, charitable organisations, and other organisations providing public information service of a non-commercial nature.
- (k) A prohibition of party-political activities.
- (l) The power to levy a charge, if required.
- (m) The power to issue a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) for contraventions.
- (n) The power to allocate use of a parking place in and outside of bays provided.
