# Summary

This report sets out the monitoring position for the Chief Executive's 2016-17 capital budget for the period from April 2016 to the end of September 2016.

#### 1 Introduction

1.1 This report comments on the monitoring position for the Chief Executive's Office capital budget for the period to 31 September 2016.

## 2. Monitoring position to September 2016

- 4.1 **Appendix 1** sets out the capital budget and monitoring for the first two quarters of the year. The Chief Executive's Office' budget has two capital budget headings for the financial year 2016/17: Capital Discretionary Fund and Inverness City Gateways. At present, these two headings amount to a gross budget of £0.308m, with £0.278m spent to date. This budget will increase as and when Capital Discretionary Funding is drawn down by new projects that have received member approval.
- 4.2 The Capital Discretionary Fund has committed financial support to 5 projects in the current financial year amounting to £0.308m. These are: Highland Hospice (£0.088m); Inverness Ice Centre (£0.155m); Alexandra Bridge (£0.026m); Kirkmichael Heritage Trust (£0.033m); and Evanton Community Trust (£0.011m) of which, there is still £0.101m to draw down.

### 5. Implications

#### 6. Recommendation
