1.0 BACKGROUND

2.0 SITE DESCRIPTION

2.1 The site comprises the existing Tain Royal Academy site, located south of the town centre of Tain at Scotsburn Road. The site is a total size of approximately 6.20 hectares and comprises the existing school buildings located centrally within the site and associated playing fields. The school is a 3 storey building at the north end, 2 storeys in the central area with a single storey section. The school was built in 1969 with an extension added in 1978. The area surrounding the site is predominately residential in nature.


