## **PLANS**

In addition to the minimum <u>validation requirements</u> for planning applications, you must provide a LAYOUT PLAN of the proposed working showing the following:-

- Boundary of the site and any adjoining land under the control of the applicant;
- Area already worked;
- Area proposed to be worked and the phases of working;
- Sites of any existing and proposed tips for dumping spoil and overburden;
- Sites proposed for the storage of materials;
- Depth, length and orientation of the working face;
- Site for the storage of any explosives;
- Site of existing and proposed buildings and plant (include elevation drawings);
- Position and width of existing and proposed access points;
- Details of the phases of reinstatement (inclusive of detailed sections, landscaping and proposed removal of any structures, plant and machinery, access, boundary treatment, management and aftercare).
