

## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SCOTLAND) ACT 1997

NOTICE is hereby given that The Highland Council propose to make an order under Section 208 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 stopping up of the footpaths described in the Schedule hereto.

The title of the order is "The Highland Council (Proposed West Link Road (A6128), Stage 1 - Various Footpaths, Inverness) (Stopping Up) Order 2014."

## SECTIONS OF FOOTPATHS TO BE STOPPED UP

- 1. That part of the footpath known as Ness-Side Circuits (IN19.36), extending to 330 metres or thereby.
- 2. That part of the footpath known as Ness-Side Circuits (IN19.36) extending to 66 metres or thereby.
- 3. That part of the footpath known as Ness-Side Circuits (IN19.36), extending to 82 metres or thereby.
- 4. That part of the footpath known as Ness-Side Circuits (IN19.36), extending to 134 metres or thereby.
- 5. That part of the footpath known as Caledonian Canal (IN19.17), extending to 170 metres or thereby.
