

**THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL
(B970 KINGUSSIE – SPEYBRIDGE ROAD) RUTHVEN ROAD, KINGUSSIE
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2014**

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as 'The Highland Council (B970 Kingussie – Speybridge Road) Ruthven Road, Kingussie (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014' and shall come into operation on Friday 14th November 2014 and shall remain in force until Monday 17th November 2014.
2. The reason for making this Order is to allow essential repair works to be carried out on Ruthven Road Level Crossing by Network Rail.
3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. All provisions contained in any Order, Enactment or others in so far as the same repeat or are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order and the true intent or meaning hereof shall cease to have effect during the period stated in Article 1 of this Order.
5. The use by vehicles of the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto is prohibited during the period stated in Article 1 of this Order.

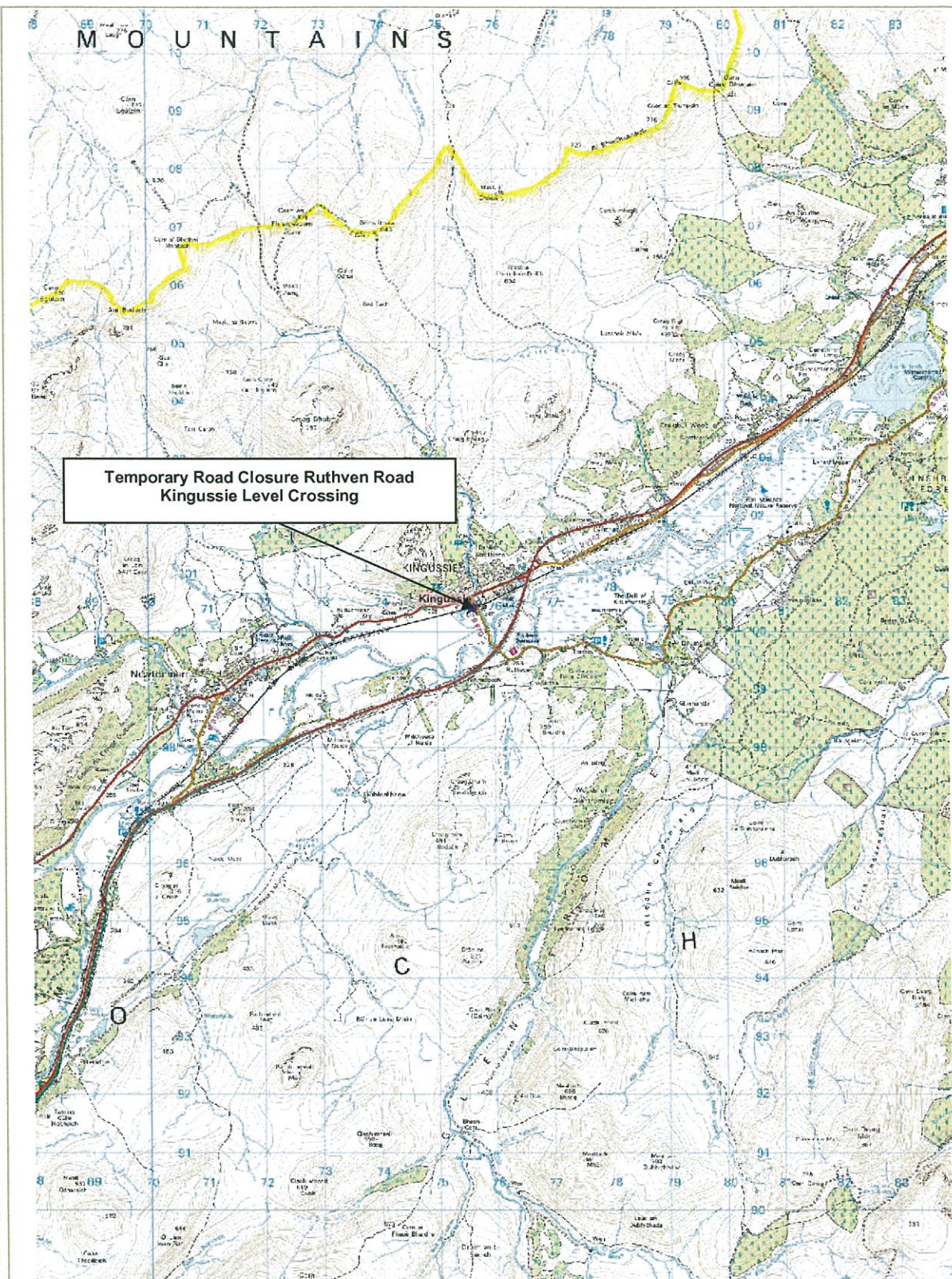
