

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL

On 23rd October 2014 the Council made the **(B970 Kingussie – Speybridge Road (Part)) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions) Order 2014** under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and related legislation, to introduce a temporary closure of that part of the B970 Kingussie – Speybridge Road at Ruthven Road Level Crossing, commencing at its junction with the C1141 Duke Street – Spey Street and its junction with the U2686 Market Lane, Kingussie, a distance of 125 metres (136 yards), or thereby. Alternative routes for vehicles will be available using the B970 Kingussie – Speybridge Road (Part), A86 Kingussie to Kerrow Road, B9152 Kingussie to Granish Road and C1132 Kincaig to Loch Insh Road (only vehicles with a gross vehicle weight of less than 17 Tonnes due to weight restriction at Kincaig Spey Bridge). Pedestrian access will be maintained via the nearby footbridge. The restriction is required to enable essential repair works to be carried out on Ruthven Road Level Crossing by Network Rail and shall come into effect on Friday 14th November 2014 and shall remain in force until Monday 17th November 2014.
