## **NEW SITES AND ISSUES CONSULTATION**

Between 30 October 2014 and 6 February 2015 the Council carried out a consultation on the first stage of the CaSPlan, known as the Main Issues Report. During the consultation some people suggested new sites that had not previously been considered for inclusion in the Plan or changes to the boundaries of sites. Others suggested alternative land uses on certain sites that had been included in the Main Issues Report. In addition some comments suggested giving "Growing Settlement" status to other places, and others suggested new Economic Development Areas.

Having carried out an initial assessment to identify reasonable options, the Council is now asking for people's views on the sites and issues suggested. Comments submitted will be considered alongside others submitted during the Main Issues Report consultation. This will help us to decide what to include in the next stage of the Plan, known as the Proposed Plan. The Council is only consulting on these new sites and issues; the consultation on the Main Issues Report has finished. Any comments received on anything other than these particular new sites and issues will not be considered.

The consultation will run for 6 weeks from 13 March to 24 April 2015. All comments must be submitted by this date in order to be considered.
