Interim Reporting

July 2006

Following hard work with stakeholders through Collaboration for Success and appropriate technical considerations, Framework options for Inverness East and Nairn South have been developed.

In addition, a draft Green Framework for the Corridor as a whole has been prepared.

The above have been submitted to The Highland Council in the form of an interim report. This will allow the Nairnshire Committee on 8 August, the Inverness and Area Committee on 14 August and the Planning, Development, Tourism and Europe Committee on 16 August to consider matters and agree that wider public consultation should be undertaken.

Subject to the Committees' considerations, the options and draft Green Framework will be reported in the August issue of this newsletter.

Strategic Environmental Assessment

The scoping report for the supporting SEA has been prepared and submitted to the Consulting Authorities (e.g. SNH, SEPA, Historic Scotland, etc). Strategic environmental assessment in progressing in tandem with the development of the Green, Inverness East and Nairn South frameworks.
