13 What are the next steps?





We will analyse the responses we get from the public, community groups and stakeholders to ensure that the scheme taken forward is one that benefits the widest sections of your community. This will feed back into finalising the outline design of the scheme along with some additional surveys and investigations that will be completed over the next few months. This information will then be used to prepare the draft Flood Protection Order which The Highland Council will then consider. A FPO gives consent for the proposed works to progress. It also means that the works have deemed planning permission.
