3.4 Why should the land be protected?

The local township has regularly spoken out against plans from individuals to build housing 'below the road'. They feel that it should be protected as crofting land – being the best quality land in the township. Geary is one of the few remaining crofting 'ribbon developments' and any development on the east side of the road would destroy that. In addition, the poor quality of the road does not lend itself to increased traffic volumes.
