



RIVER NESS FLOOD ALLEVIATION SCHEME - PHASE 2

PROJECT UPDATE June 2015

Huntly Place/Gilbert Street

Installation of drainage services and kerbing detail is now complete. Area continues to be prepared for surface reinstatement. Sandstone cladding to both faces of the flood defence wall is nearing completion. Positioning of coping stones and installation of safety handrail system has commenced.

Thornbush Quay

Pedestrian footpath surfacing has been reinstated and all pebble dash facing is now complete. Installation of new street lighting columns is on-going.

Kessock Road

Drainage service and kerb detail installation is now complete. Surface reinstatement to carriageway and pedestrian footpath has commenced.

Riverside Street

Area continues to be prepared for surface reinstatement to access road and carpark. Kerbing detail, drainage services and pumping station is now complete. First and second fixings of safety handrail system upon flood defence wall is scheduled to commence.

Portland Place

Brick paving reinstatement & French drain installation is complete in this area. Pebble dash facing is also complete. Installation of the flood defence wall coping stones and safety handrail second fixings scheduled to commence.

Caledonian Oils

Concrete works to flood defence wall is scheduled to be completed by the middle of June. Brick paving reinstatement is on-going in this area.

Cromwell Road/Longman Drive

Concrete works to flood defence wall are now complete at this section. Installation of street lighting columns and footpath preparation for surface reinstatement is on-going.
