THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (BLACK ISLE SHOW) ORDER 2015

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11 (1) of the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003 ("the Act") hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Highland Council (Black Isle Show) Order 2015", and shall come into operation at 0001 on Wednesday 5 August 2015 and shall expire at 0200 on Friday 7 August 2015.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The effect of the Order is to exempt land, namely the Mannsfield Showground, Muir of Ord, Ross-shire shown delineated in black on the plan annexed and signed as relative to this Order, from the access rights which would otherwise be exercisable in respect of that land by virtue of Part 1 of the Act. Rights of way are not affected by this Order.


