

Rhind house is situated off West Bank Avenue in the market town of Wick which has a population of 7,300. The property is approximately 5 minutes' walk from Wick railway station. Wick airport is a short drive away and provides regular flights to Aberdeen & Edinburgh.

The property was built as a substantial detached solid stone dwelling house which has been converted to provide office accommodation. There is also a substantial extension which provides basic storage accommodation.
