The Caithness and Sutherland Local Development Plan (CaSPlan) – Modified Proposed Plan was submitted by The Highland Council to the Scottish Ministers on 6 April 2017.

The version of CaSPlan submitted is the Modified Proposed Plan (September 2016) without any further modifications being made to it. In submitting CaSPlan to the Scottish Ministers, the Council has requested the appointment of a Reporter to undertake the Examination of the outstanding issues. Those outstanding issues have been identified by the Council following its consideration of all the relevant representations that it had received on the Proposed Plan (January 2016) and those it received on the Modified Proposed Plan (September 2016).

Once notified of the appointment of a Reporter, the Council will advertise the forthcoming Examination and that notice will also be sent to all those persons and organisations from whom the Council received relevant representations on the Proposed Plan and/or the Modified Proposed Plan, providing more information about the Examination stage.
