- 4. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 8 June 2017.
- 5. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom or by means of a building society cheque, a debit or credit card or the electronic transfer of funds. Payment by a credit card will incur a 2% surcharge which is non-refundable.
- 6. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer (ERO) by 5.00 p.m. on Tuesday 23 May 2017.
- 7. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer (ERO) by 5.00 p.m. on Wednesday 31 May 2017.
- 8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election applied for on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5.00 p.m. on Thursday 8 June 2017. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5.00 p.m. on Wednesday 31 May 2017. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5.00 p.m. on Wednesday 31 May 2017.
