- This Order may be cited as "The Highland Council (Strathpuffer 2018)
 Order 2017", and shall come into operation at 1400hrs on Friday 19th
 January 2018. The Order shall expire at 1200hrs on Sunday 21st January
 2018 unless revoked earlier.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The effect of the Order is to exempt land within Torachilty Forest, Contin delineated in blue on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto from the access rights which would otherwise be exercisable in respect of the land by virtue of Part 1 of the Act. Rights of way are not affected by this Order.
