The document contains both the original Proposed Plan version and the As Modified version of the relevant maps/diagrams/figures; and also relevant text indicating the Modifications.




Examination Report – Recommended Modifications

In Figure 1 -

- Place names should be included in association with symbols on the map, as far as possible.





Figure 3: Inner Moray Firth Vision and Spatial Strategy

 (For consistency, the same should apply to Figures 2 and 3 also.)
- The location of the facilities indicated by those symbols should be clarified by one of the methods referred to at paragraph # above, or by an equivalent method.
- The linear notation for "Potential offshore renewable energy" should be replaced by an area notation.
- The approximate line of the proposed High Voltage Direct Current cable from Caithness to Moray should be added.

In Figure 1 -

- Figure 2 map should be headed "Vision and Spatial Strategy".

Examination Report – Recommended Modifications In *Figure* 3 -

- the title on the map should read "Vision and Spatial Strategy Inner Moray Firth".
- apply the "improved rail connection" notation to the Aberdeen railway line.
- delete "Improved air connection" and put instead Improved and international air connection
- delete the waste facility symbol from the vicinity of Invergordon.
- the scale of the mapping should be enlarged by about one-third, so that the Inner Moray Firth area extends across the full width of the map; and
- the size of the symbols should be enlarged.






Figure 4: City of Inverness Spatial Strategy




Map 3: Muirtown and South Kessock







Figure 5: A96 Corridor Strategy







- improve the clarity of the lettering




Map 6: East Inverness



- Amend phasing in respect of land at Milton of Culloden and Stratton Lodge as commended by the Council.




Map 7: Tornagrain









Map 11: Ardersier Expansion



- identify the Milton of Connage site by name, to distinguish it from the other residential allocations.




Proposed Plan version Map 12: Cawdor Expansion



Map 13: Nigg Development Masterplan Area




Alter Map 14: Nigg Development Master Plan Area as follows -




Map 14: Dounreay




Map 15: John O'Groats: Masterplan






Map 16: Castletown Masterplan

Map 18: Glen Nevis Business Park




Figure 9: Location of Existing and Proposed Waste Facilities in Highland


