

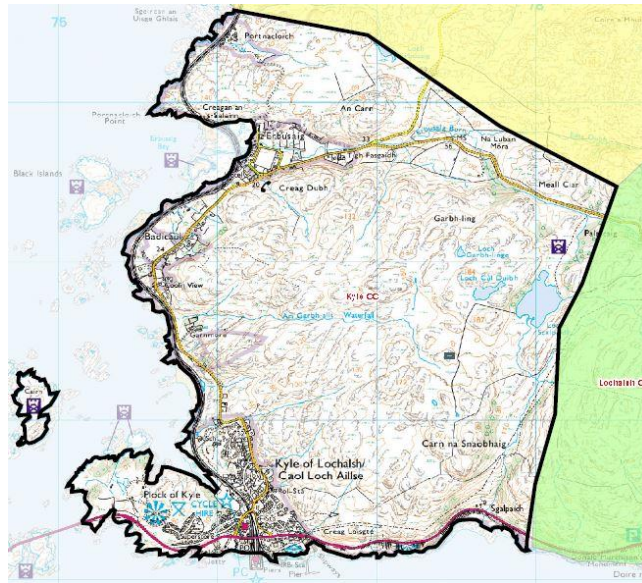

A Community Group Event

The Lochalsh local councillors have set aside £4,000 from the Ward Discretionary Budget, and a further £6,000 has been added by the Scottish Government to run a participatory budgeting event to let the local community decide for themselves which projects they want and need in their area.

What can you apply for?

We need your ideas for projects that will:

- Benefit as many people as possible from across the community
- Help to make Kyle a better place for everyone
- Add value to existing projects

Any project – large or small – is welcome to apply...

Whether you want to organise a Highland Dancing Championship, after school unicycle club, a lunch club for older residents, or a community arts project. The only limit is your imagination and your project or idea happening within 12 months.

Who can apply?

Any local community, voluntary or non-profit organisation can **apply for funding from £200 to £2,000** to put ideas into action; with one bid permitted per organisation.

All activities will have to happen in the Kyle Community Council Area by Lochalsh based organisations and benefit local people.

How do you apply?

To apply for the funding, you must return this form before **5pm Friday 16th February 2018.**

The community will vote for the best ideas at an event on Saturday 17th March 2018, 10am – 1pm.

Event

The event will be held at the **Kyle Village Hall**, doors open at 9.30am. At the event applicants will be required to present their ideas to the community.

Those in attendance will then vote on all the applications and winners will be announced on the day.
