Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that a requirement of that Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the Court of Session.

#### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

The Highland Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Decriminalised Parking Enforcement and Consolidation) Variation One Order 2017

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 19, 32, 35, 45, 46,47 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") as amended and of the Road Traffic Act 1991 ("the 1991 Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

- This Order shall come into operation on the 19<sup>th</sup> March 2018 and may be cited as "The Highland Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Decriminalised Parking Enforcement and Consolidation) Variation One Order 2017"
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment provided that where a prohibition or restriction which is imposed, varied or revoked by this Order is in conflict with a prohibition or restriction imposed by a previous Order, then the provision of this Order shall prevail.
- If a court, Transport Scotland or the Parking and Bus Lane Tribunal Service for Scotland, declares any part of this Order to be invalid or un-enforceable, such declaration shall not invalidate the remainder of this Order.

5. The Highland Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Decriminalised Parking Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2016 (hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order") is hereby varied: the plans specified in the Schedule 1 to this Order are delete from the Principal Order and the plans specified and attached in Schedule 2 to this Order are substituted therefore and hereby added and incorporated into schedule 1 to the Principal Order.

This Order and the Schedules annexed hereto are sealed with the Common Seal of The Highland Council and subscribed for them and on their behalf by Lesley Howie, Legal Manager, Conveyancing & Commercial, Proper Officer at Inverness on the Fourteenth day of March Two Thousand and Eighteen.


