

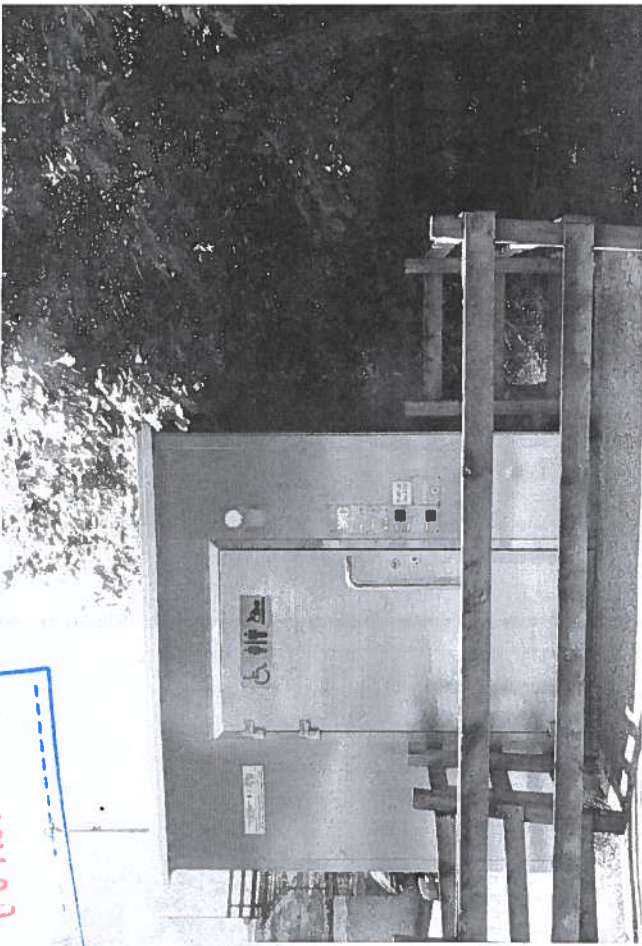
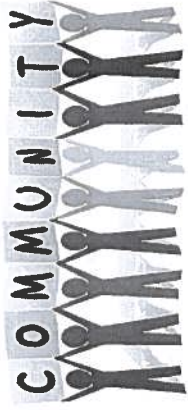
Beach Toilet Project

Highland Council's plans to close public toilets have long been on the agenda and 18 months ago Gairloch Community Council began talks with Highland Council to transfer the land to the community at the beach car park, pull down the old derelict building and build a new community owned and managed toilet and shower facility. **GAIRLOCH AREA DEVELOPMENT**, a company limited by guarantee was started as Community Councils can no longer own property and an application went in for the transfer of land to the community.

The process now needs evidence of community support and we ask you to sign your support on the sheets at either **Cornerstone, Farm Garden or Shop at the Pier** or on the posting on Gairloch Community Council facebook page. Please sign if you think there should be community toilet provision at Gairloch Beach Car Park – without toilet facilities we lose the prestigious European Bathing Waters designation!

The mobile toilet, affectionately known locally as 'the tardis' is destined for Sutherland but Highland Council have assured us it will remain where it is while the community project progresses.

NB. We are told the toilet provision at the Pier is also under review and Community Council is investigating but at the moment we are asking for support for the Beach Car Park toilet community replacement. The battle for the Pier may well come later!!
