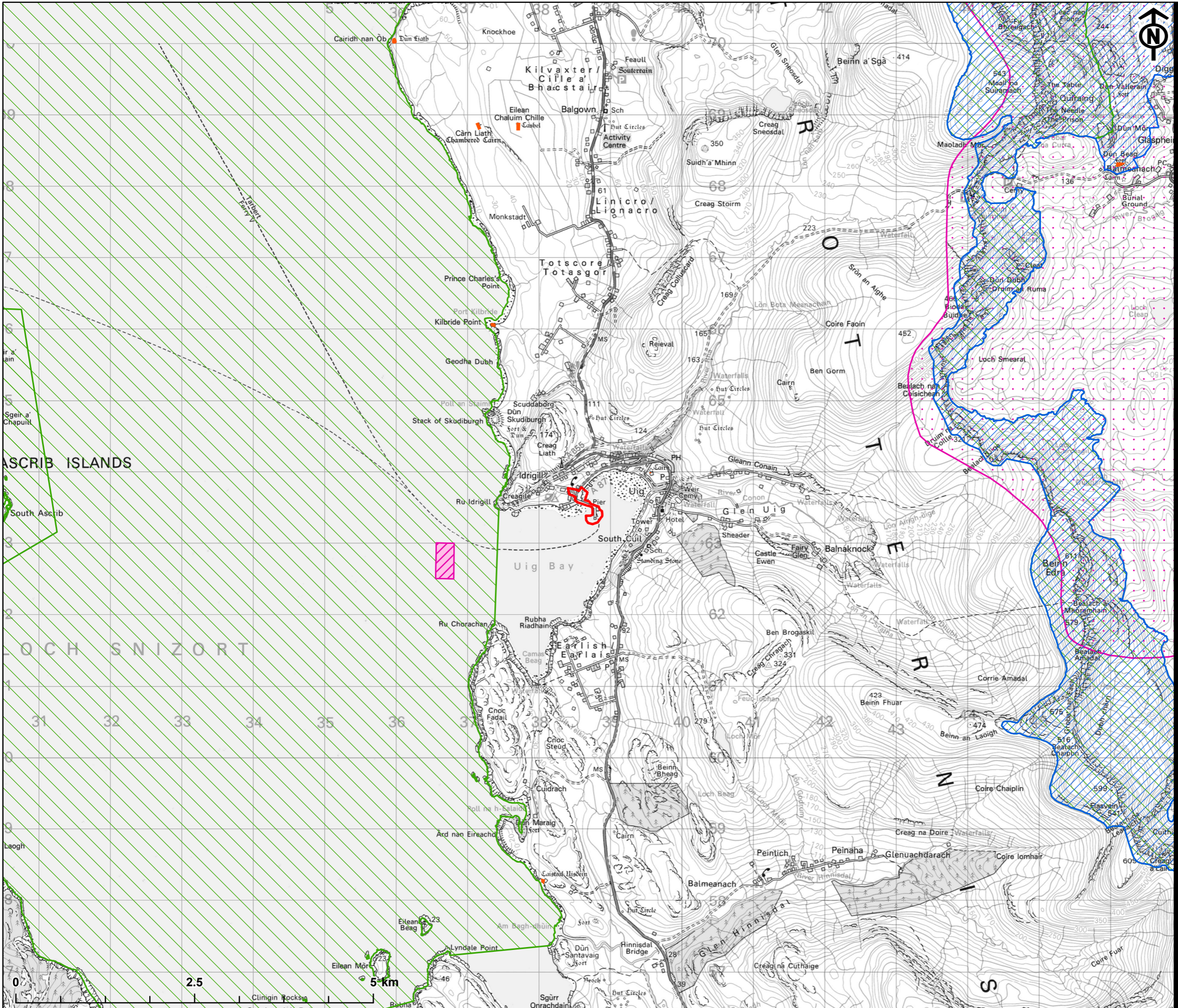

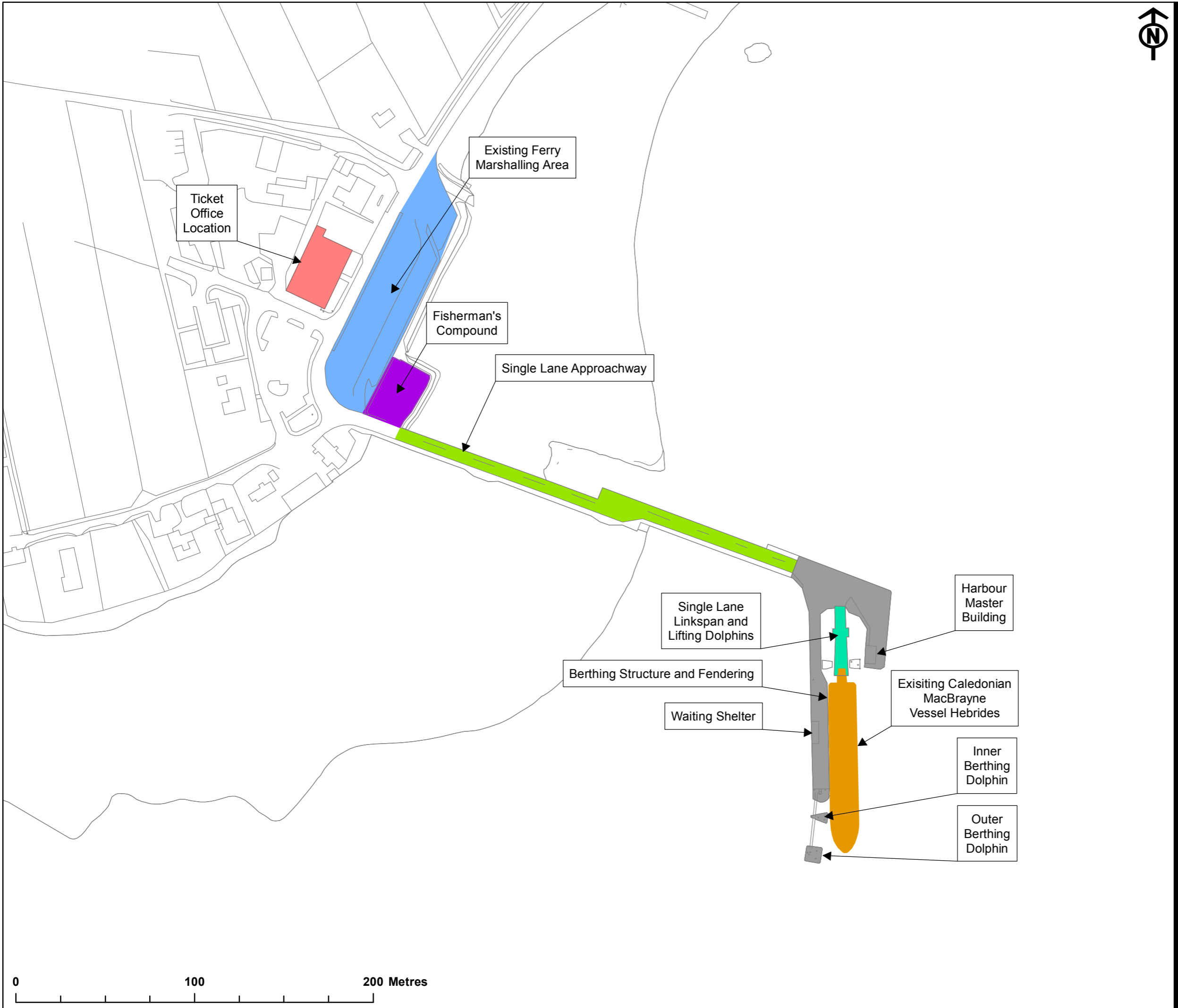

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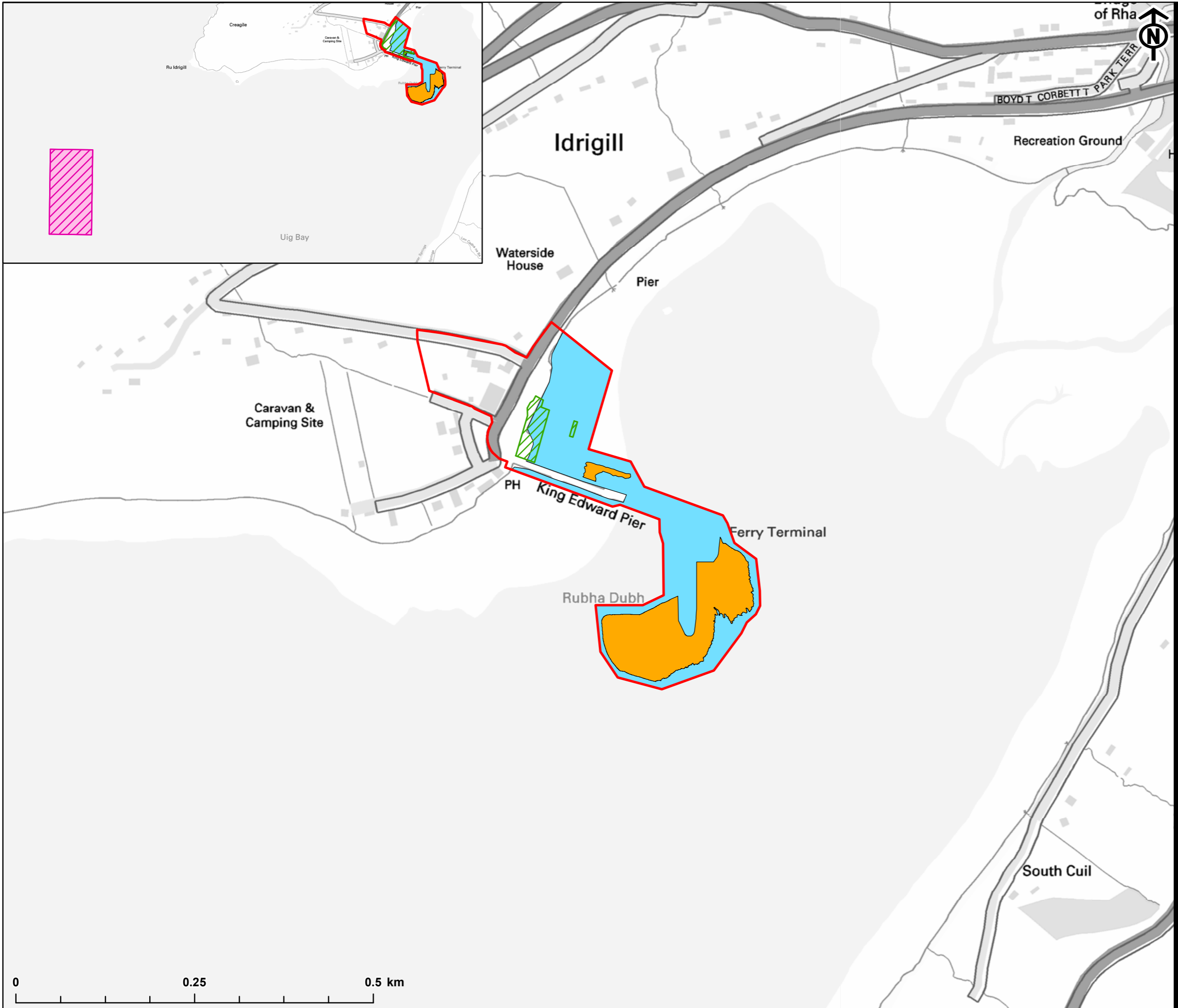

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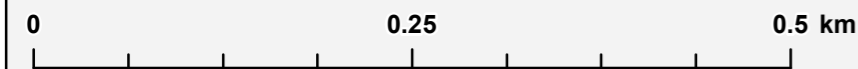

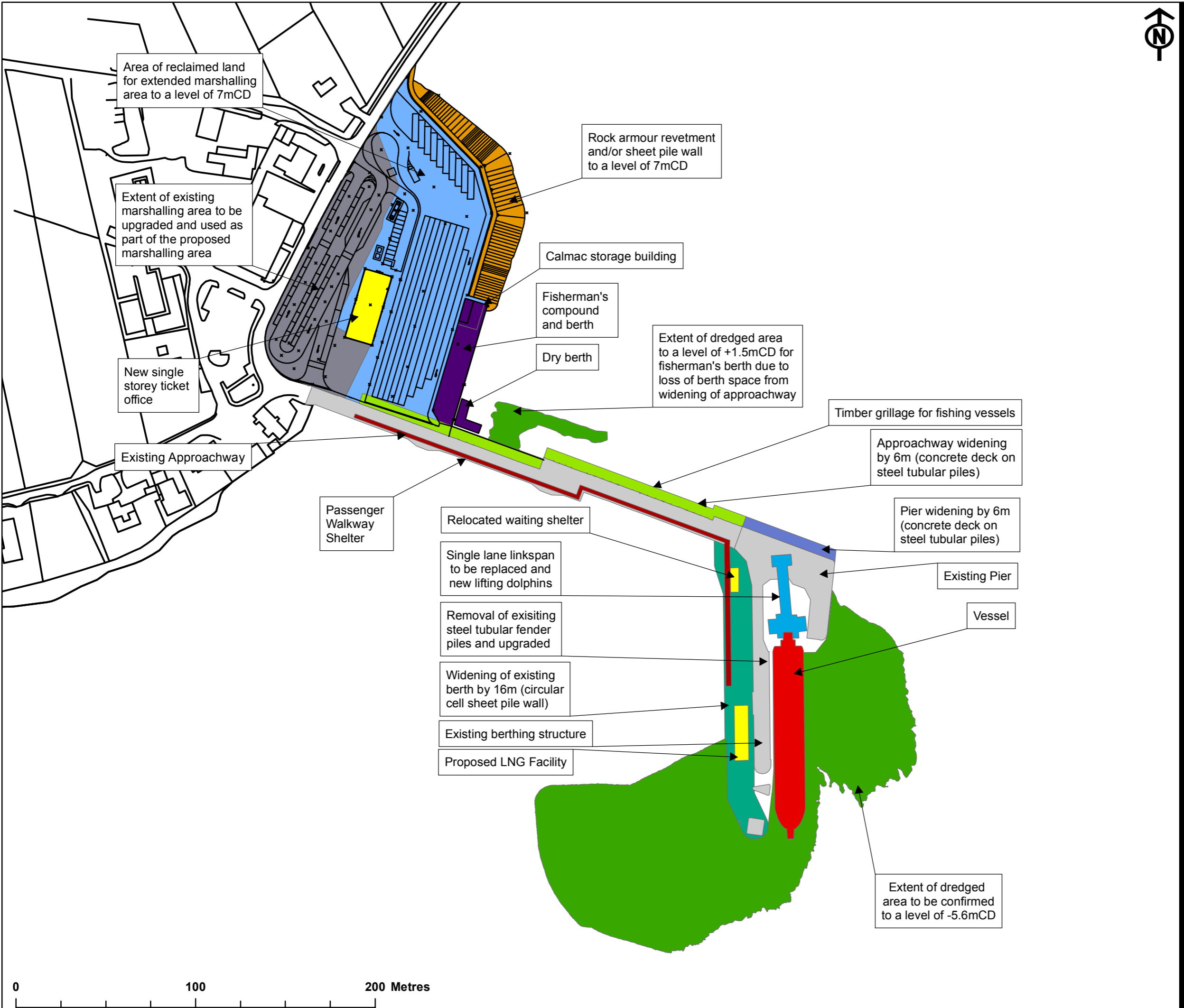
Figure 3.3 Layout of the

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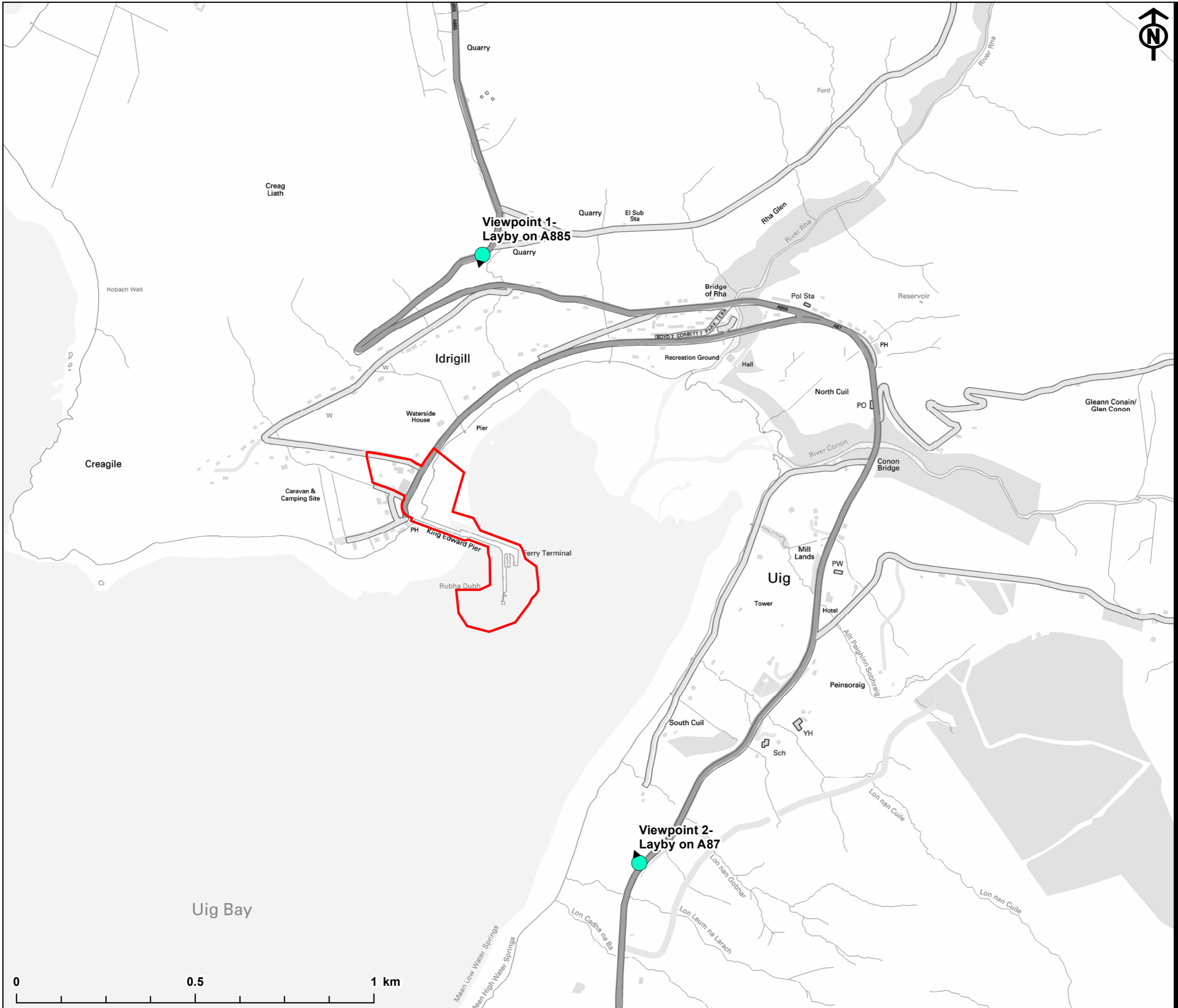

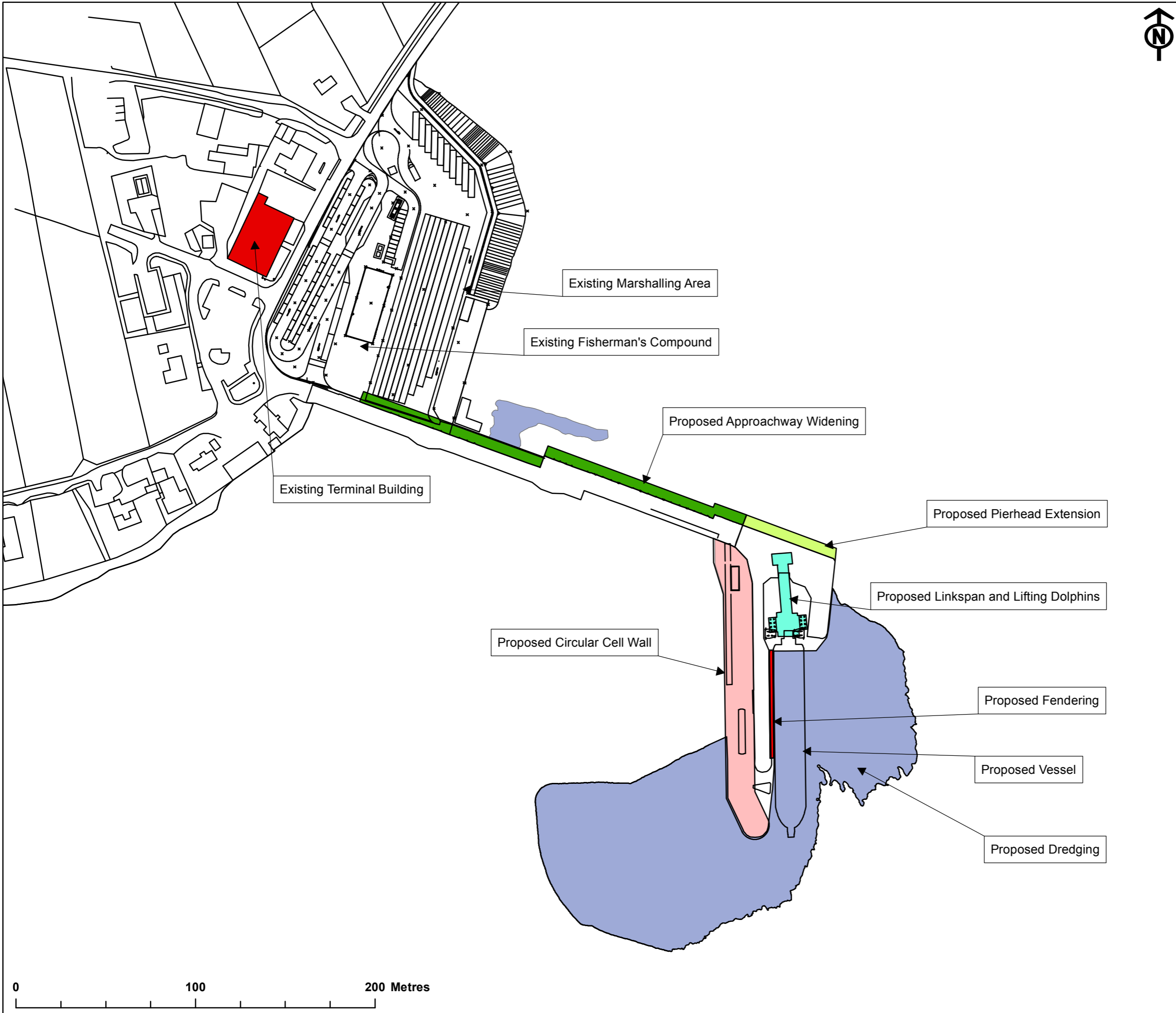
Figure 3.4c: Viewpoint 02 - Layby on A885

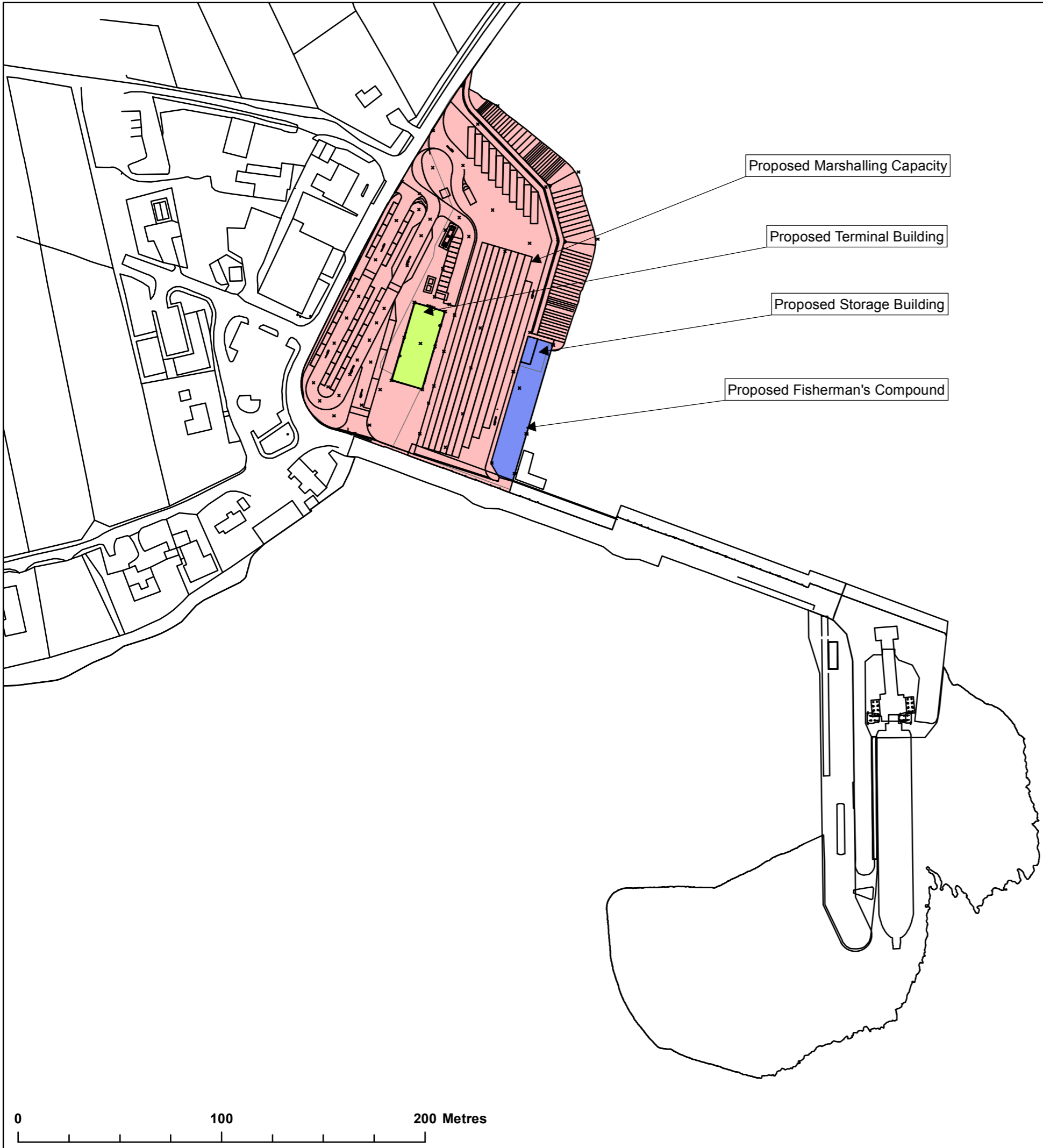

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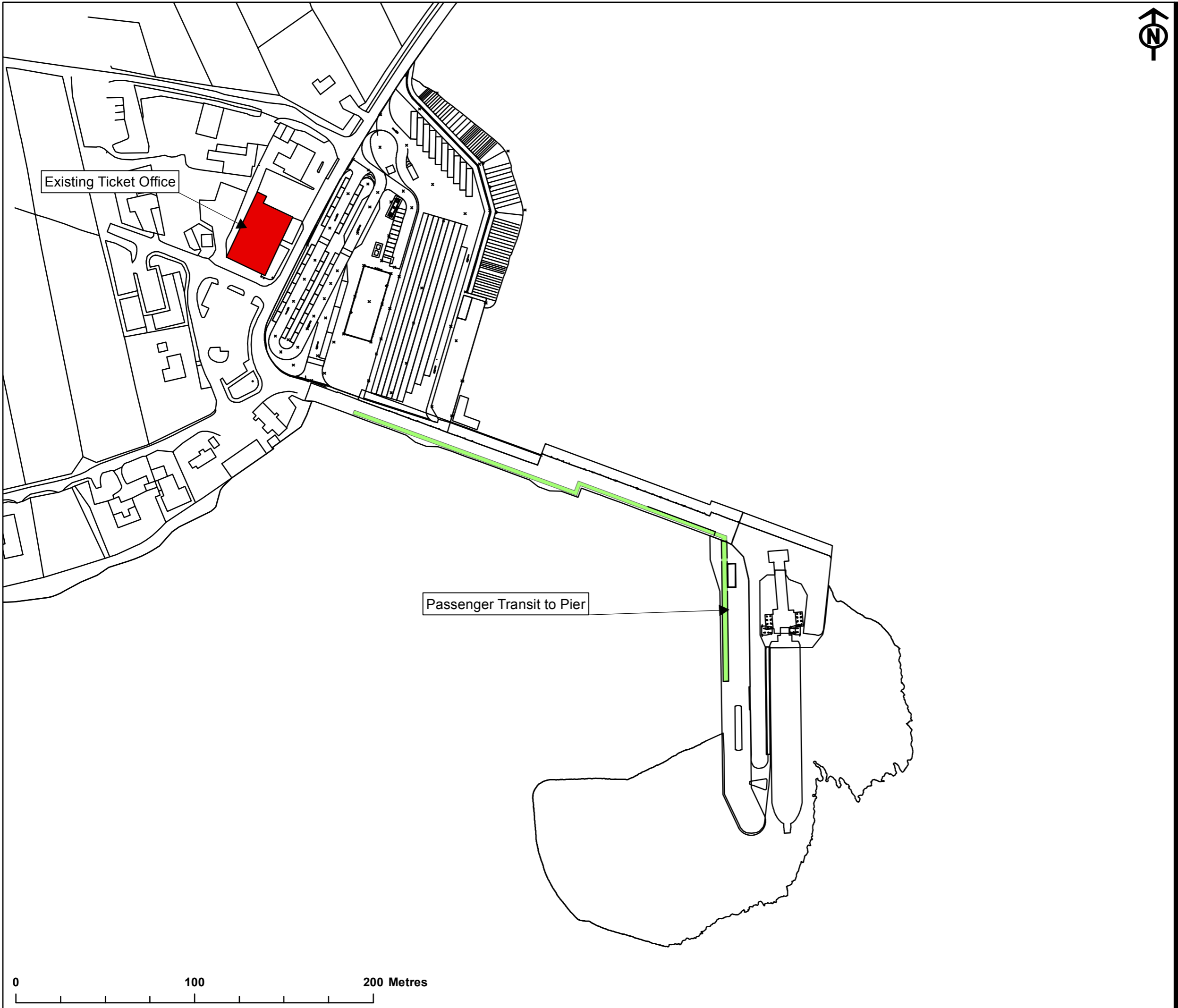

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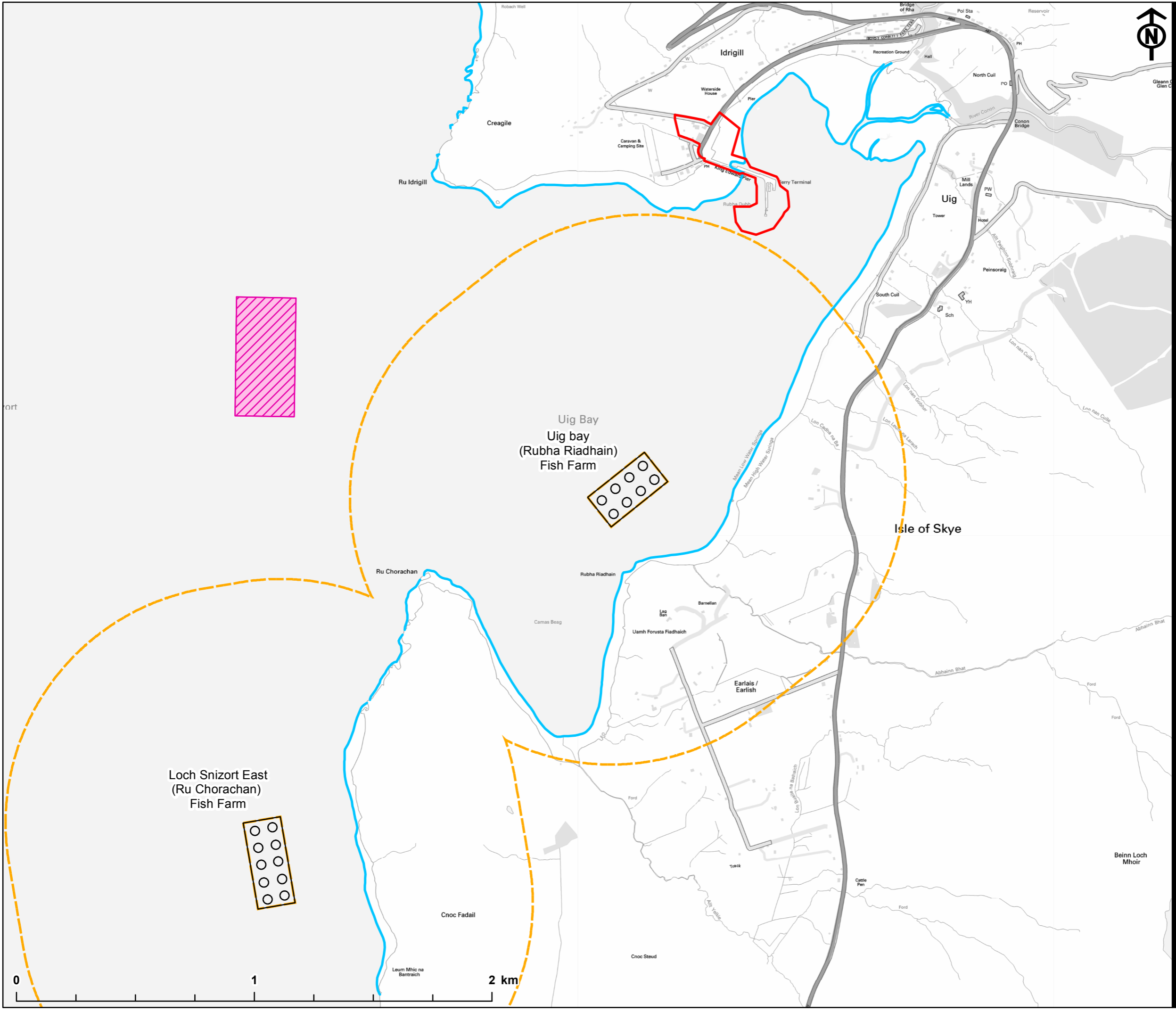
