Car Park at Kilmallie Community Centre

Kilmallie Community Council is concerned that the current ownership of the car park at Kilmallie Community Centre has resulted in it being in a poor state of repair. In particular, the disabled parking spaces are not fit for purpose because of rough and uneven ground.

We welcome the attempts by the Community Centre to raise funds to improve the car park and provide adequate disabled parking facilities, as well as an electric car charging point, tap for fresh water and disposal facilities for chemical toilets.

The location of the Community Centre, which is immediately adjacent to the A830, is ideal for providing facilities for passing visitors. Visitors who stop to charge their cars, use the toilets or the chemical toilet disposal are also more likely to visit the local shop or Treasures of the Earth museum.

We understand that in order to seek funding for the car park improvements it is necessary first to transfer ownership of the car park from Highland Council to the Kilmallie Community Centre. We would support this transfer if it brings the expected opportunities to improve the facilities.
