# Highland Council Community Asset Transfer Annual Report 1<sup>st</sup> of April 2018 to 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2019

The Highland Council is committed to supporting a Community Asset Transfer process that supports communities to identify their needs and take control of the assets they require to deliver better outcomes for communities.

We are continuing to improve and develop a clear Community Asset Transfer process that engages with communities and harnesses the expertise of a variety of Council officers and partner agencies to inform our approach and decision-making on asset transfer.

This second Annual Report on Community Asset Transfer covers the period from 1st of April 2018 to 31st of March 2019.

The report outlines:

- the number of requests received;
- the level and nature of those requests (full or expression of interest);
- detail of full asset transfer requests received;
- status of asset transfer requests;
- information on the type of property requested;
- the geographical spread of requests across Highland, by ward.

#### **Highland Council Process**

A two-stage process enables communities to log an expression of interest prior to submitting a full asset transfer request. This supports communities to have a point of contact to support them through the request process, access supporting information they require for their application and signpost them to wider sources of support within the community.

A single point of contact has been established for groups to direct enquires, expressions of interest and full asset transfer requests. A map of all Council properties has been established to support groups to identify whether assets they are interested in are owned by the organisation. A separate process for any review of decisions has also been implemented.

## Community Asset Transfer Summary Information

For the period 1st of April 2018 to 31st of March 2019:

- **49** expressions of interest have been received
- **15** full community asset transfer requests have been received
- Of the **15** full asset transfer requests received:
  - 8 have been agreed;
  - None were rejected;
  - **3** are under consideration;
  - **4** were withdrawn by the Community Transfer Body.
