The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11 (1) of the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003 ("the Act") hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Highland Council (Skeabost Rally, Skeabost Forestry, Isle of Skye) Order 2019", and shall come into operation at 08:00hrs until 18.00hrs on Saturday 28th September 2019 unless revoked earlier.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The effect of the Order is to exempt land, namely land at Skeabost Forestry, Isle of Skye shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and signed as relative to this Order, from the access rights which would otherwise be exercisable in respect of that land by virtue of Part 1 of the Act. Rights of way are not affected by this Order.


