An asset transfer request has been made to The Highland Council under Part 5 of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015.

The request has been made by Am Fasgadh Regeneration Company (Kingussie) Ltd. for purchase of land and buildings comprising MacRobert House, former museum store and workshops, for the development of a community venue, to include a cinema, garden and events space and 'hubs' for digital health and cycling projects.
