

Inverness West Link Stage 2 – August 2020 Update

Progress

Another good month for progress across the site with the installation of the precast box culverts for the underpass under the A82, construction of stone headwalls and blockwork for the plant room. The drilling and grouting of voids behind the sheet piles. A number of concrete pours on the West Abutment apron slabs and retaining walls and the installation of precast wall sections along the wharf. The piles were installed for the new timber Jetty to the North of the existing Tomnahurich Swing Bridge.
