

**THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL**  
**B817 FYRISH CRESCENT, EVANTON, RAISED TABLE AND BUILDOUT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **The Highland Council**, in terms of the powers contained in section 36 and 37 of the **Roads (Scotland) Act 1984** as amended and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf **propose to construct 1 raised table and 1 build out** on the B817 Fyrish Crescent, Evanton as follows:

- Raised table on B817 Fyrish Crescent located 90 metres or thereby Northeast of its junction with the U2000 Fyrish Crescent, Evanton. Table 75mm in height (max) 4.5m wide and 5m long.
- Build out on B817 Fyrish Crescent, Evanton located 155 metres or thereby Northeast of its junction with the U2000 Fyrish Crescent, Evanton. Build out located in Southbound lane, 1.5m wide and 6.6m long.

In terms of Section 7 and Schedule 6 Part 3 paragraph 9 of the Coronavirus (Scotland) Act 2020, the Council has decided not to make the schedule and plans available for public inspection or publicise them other than by electronic means because to do otherwise may give rise to a significant risk of the transmission of coronavirus.
