I am aware that Grantown Initiative are looking to secure an asset transfer of the toilets in Burnfield car park, with a view to re-opening and operating them.

The loss of these toilets has been a major headache for Grantown Motormania, which is held in The Square on the first Sunday in September annually. We welcome approximately 5,000 spectators to our event and Burnfield is on the main walking route to the event from our designated car park in the Showfield. Burnfield is also used by Motormania as overspill parking for event entrants. Since the facility was closed Motormania has trebled the number of portable toilets which have to be hired in, and we also rely on the generosity of local businesses to provide toilet facilities. The public toilets situated at the bottom end of High Street are simply too far away from our event and are irrelevant.

Motormania is happy to support any application for asset transfer.
