

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (U4067 KING STREET AT ST JOSEPHS PRIMARY SCHOOL, INVERNESS) ROAD HUMPS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council, in terms of the powers contained in section 36 and 37 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 as amended and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf propose to construct road humps on the U4067 as follows:

- A pair of road humps located 15 m or thereby southeast of the centre line of the U4067 King Street and U3881 Duncraig Street junction.

The length of the road humps is 1.9 metres, each road hump is 1.6 m in width. The road humps are set in 0.8 m from the road edge and there is 1.2 m between them.

In terms of Section 7 and Schedule 6 Part 3 paragraph 9 of the Coronavirus (Scotland) Act 2020, the Council has decided not to make the schedule and plan available for public inspection or publicise them other than by electronic means because to do otherwise may give rise to a significant risk of the transmission of coronavirus.
