**THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (DINGWALL ACADEMY AND PRIMARY SCHOOL)
(PART TIME 20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2008**

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-


GENERAL

1. This Order may be cited as "The Highland Council (Dingwall Academy and Primary School) (Part Time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2008" and shall come into effect on 15th September, 2008
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. All provisions contained in any Order, enactment or others insofar as the same are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order and the true intent and meaning thereof shall cease to have effect during the period of operation of the speed limit hereunder. In particular, The Highland Council (Various Roads, Dingwall)(30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2003 shall cease to have effect over the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto during such period of operation but shall otherwise remain in effect.

20 MPH LIMIT

4. No person shall drive or cause to be driven any vehicle to be driven on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule annexed and signed as relative to this Order at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour at a time when the amber lights on any traffic sign or signs warning of this restriction are flashing and it shall be sufficient for the purposes of this speed limit that said warning sign or signs be erected on only one side of the road.

SCHEDULE TO THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (DINGWALL ACADEMY AND PRIMARY SCHOOL) (PART TIME 20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2008 *Order of 5th September 2008*

A862 A834 Junction – Mineral Bridge Road.

From a point 32 metres or thereby southwest of the centre of the Peffery Bridge, north eastwards to a point in line with the boundary between Tulloch Place and Nursery House, a total distance of 244 metres or thereby.

C1213 Tulloch Avenue

From a point 28 metres or thereby north west of the centreline of its junction with the A862 Craig Road, north westwards to a point 4 metres or thereby northwest of a point in line with the boundary between the properties known as No. 1 Kinnairdie Avenue and No. 2 Woodlands Road, a total distance of 164 metres or thereby.

C1213 Old Evanton Road / U4444 Dingwall Back Road

From a point on Old Evanton Road in line with the boundary between the properties known as No. 2 and No. 3 Churchill Drive, southwestwards to a point on the Dingwall Back Road 50 metres or thereby southwest of the centreline of its junction with the U4446 Bruce Avenue, a total distance of 420 metres or thereby.

U4491 Tulloch Castle Drive

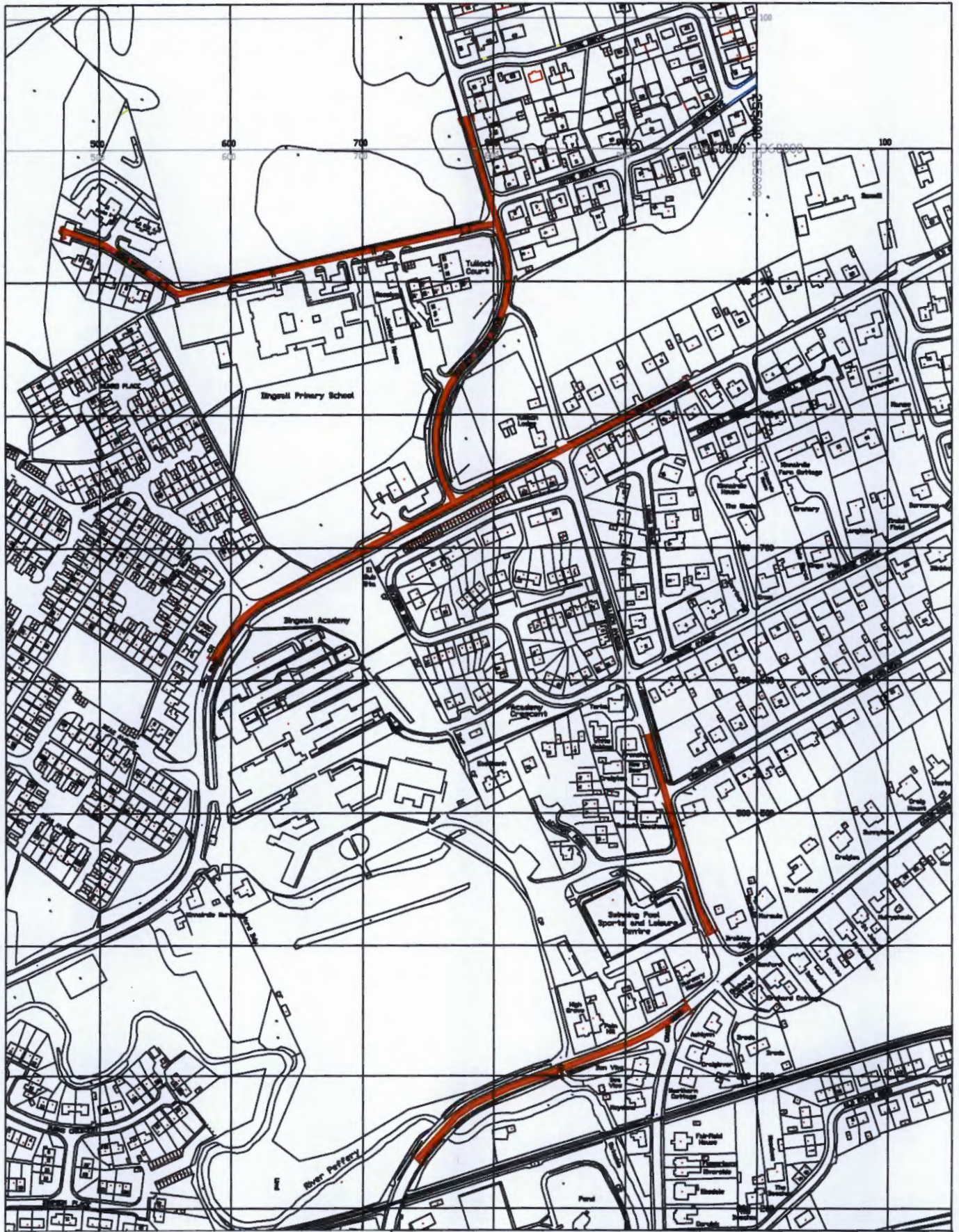
From its junction with the U4444 Dingwall Back Road, in a generally northerly direction to a point in line with the boundary between the properties known as No.14 and No. 16 Tulloch Castle Drive, a total distance of 313 metres or thereby.

U5140 Ross Avenue/Ross Place

For their entire length, a total distance of 350 metres or thereby.
