Raasay Distillery has been operating since September 2017, to date we have filled over 1000 casks and welcomed over 4500 visitors. We employed over 20 people during last season and have ambitious plans to increase visitor numbers and create more jobs, both seasonal and full time, in the coming year.

The pontoon project is of great interest to us as a business, bringing in trade that would ordinarily pass us by. The development of safe, high quality docking and berthing facilities will also increase the viability of potential boat tours or water taxis coming to Raasay. Raasay has a great deal going for it right now but transport links could be much better. We need investment in facilities and development of alternative routes of access to the island.

New pontoons would be a great benefit to both the distillery as a business and the wider Raasay community. Ambitious projects like this will allow us and other businesses grow and in turn support jobs, making Raasay a more attractive place to live, work and visit.
