NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **The Highland Council**, in terms of the powers contained in section 36 of the **Roads (Scotland) Act 1984** as amended, The Road Humps (Scotland) Regulations 1998, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf proposes to construct 1 raised table with uncontrolled pedestrian crossing and 1 raised table with controlled pedestrian crossing on the B861 Culduthel Road, Inverness as follows:

- Raised table with uncontrolled pedestrian crossing 23 metres or thereby Southwest of the U4104 Culduthel Place, B861 Culduthel Road Junction, Inverness. This raised table will be 75mm in height (max) across the carriageway kerb to kerb (6m wide). This consists of a raised section (75mm in height) 2800mm in length with two tapered ramps located on each side 1100mm wide.
- Raised table with controlled pedestrian crossing 63 metres or thereby South of the C1044
 Culduthel Avenue, B861 Culduthel Road Junction, Inverness. This raised table will be 75mm
 in height (max) across the carriageway kerb to kerb (5.5m wide). This consists of a raised
 section (75mm in height) 2700mm in length with two tapered ramps located on each side
 1100mm wide. Road markings for zebra crossing will be reinstated as per the Traffic Signs
 Regulations and General Directions 2016.

In terms of Section 7 and Schedule 6 Part 3 paragraph 9 of the Coronavirus (Scotland) Act 2020, the Council has decided not to make the schedule and plans available for public inspection or publicise them other than by electronic means because to do otherwise may give rise to a significant risk of the transmission of coronavirus.
