Why is it important ?

The internet is a technological wonder, pushing the boundaries of the way we live. We communicate through email and facetime, share our thoughts and opinions on twitter, buy stuff on Amazon, conduct business transactions online, watch movies on Netflix and even medical diagnosis is done via the internet. It is impossible to imagine life as we know today without the power of internet.

While the internet brings with it countless benefits, it is crucial for us to be aware of growing safety, security and privacy risks in the cyber world. Information in the wrong hands could have catastrophic effects on personal and professional lives.



Why use social media ?



Hear and be heard

 It is the easiest way to broadcast your ideas and get feedback from your community



A free & open platform (almost)

- In principle, social platforms do not discriminate and everyone's welcome
- Beware of selective censoring of content based
- Understand that social platforms make money through advertising served to users



It is direct and instant

- Instantly get feedback on your content
- Your content directly reaches your followers

But first, some hygiene checks



Social media accounts

- Keep track of your active and inactive accounts
- Fewer the better
- Scan for bogus/fraudulent accounts regularly and report them



Passwords



- Never ever share passwords
- Change passwords regularly
- Don't write down passwords

- Go through privacy settings for your account
- Make sure you understand who sees what before sharing anything on social media

Check, re-check the source



It's on google and hence it is true

NOT ALWAYS !



How reputed is the information source?

Does it look like fake news?

Ask yourself: Do you trust the person/organization? Watch out for manipulated headlines / hooks / images / videos

Be aware of the content you share







Be sensitive to gender / racial / age / class stereotyping Post only appropriate content – no explicit material Get your facts right ! – always publish referenceable sources

Understanding accounts and logins

- Most websites/apps offering any service requires you to create an account. The account has a username and a password which you will use to login to the account
- For additional security, some services provide a <u>2 factor authentication</u>. Along with a password, a 2nd level of authentication may be applied. This 2nd level of authentication is typically done via your mobile phone (SMS based one time passwords, approval via specialized apps on your phone etc)

Security Tip

In many cases, such as Facebook and Twitter, your email id is used as username.

However, remember to create a different password for each website/service you sign up for and never use your email password.


First, some basics

Owned by Facebook, a 1 to 1 and group communication app




Extremely popular with millennials. A short video sharing platform

To get started, you'll need




There are many email service providers such as **GMAIL, YAHOO, HOTMAIL**

In this example, we will look at GMAIL.


Setting up a free Gmail account is a quick, easy process that takes little time to complete. Below are the step-by-step instructions you'll need to create an account and start using Gmail in no time. 1. Visit <u>Create your Google Account</u> for Gmail. or type <u>https://accounts.google.com/SignUp</u> in your web browser

2. Enter your first and last name.



Tip

Your Gmail email address will be your username followed by "@gmail.com." If your Gmail username is "example," for instance, your Gmail address is <u>example@gmail.com</u>.

Google needs some fairly basic stuff to open your Gmail account: your first name, last name, the username you want, and a password typed twice.


While there's no rule that you have to use your real name like with Facebook, bear in mind that this is how your emails' recipients will see you.

3. Enter your mobile phone number and/or an alternate email address for account verification and authorization. Google uses this information to to allow you to recover a lost password.

Enter your birth date and gender (all fields are required).

4. You will be asked to verify your phone number or alternate email. It is a useful feature that can help with authentication and recovering your password in case you forget it.

Combining data


Type in <u>www.gmail.com</u> on your web browser





The email from Facebook will look something like the image below






Once you click Continue, you will get a confirmation message
