

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (C1121 TOMATIN, INVERNESS-SHIRE) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT EXTENSION) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council proposes to make an Order in terms of Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 entitled as above.

If the Order comes into force, the Order will introduce a 30mph speed limit on the following length of road in Tomatin, Inverness-shire:

Route C1121

Commencing at a point 173 metres or thereby north of its junction with the Strathdearn Primary School Access Road, Tomatin and extending north towards the A9(T) junction for a distance of 248 metres or thereby.
