

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (C1119 CARRBRIDGE – MULLUCHARD - BALNAAN ROAD, CARRBRIDGE) (20 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The Highland Council (C1119 Carrbridge – Mulluchard – Balnaan Road, Carrbridge) (20 MPH and 40MPH Speed Limit) Order 2021” and shall come into effect on tbc.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. All provisions contained in any Order enactment or others insofar as the same are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order and the true intent and meaning hereof shall cease to have effect and are hereby revoked.

ROADS (20MPH)

4. No person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed in excess of 20mph over the length of road specified in Part One of the Schedule.

ROADS (40MPH)

5. No person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed in excess of 40mph over the length of road specified in Part Two of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Part One – 20mph Speed Limit

Route C1119 – Carr Road

For its entire length.

Part Two – 40mph Speed Limit

Route C1119 – Carrbridge – Mulluchard – Balnaan Road

Commencing at a point 69 metres or thereby east of the centreline of Carr Place and extending generally north-eastwards for a distance of 250 metres or thereby.
